**Gin Fizz History.....Fizz** of mixed drinks. It is variation on the older Sours family. The defining features of the **fizz** are an acidic juice (such as lemon or lime juice) and carbonated water. The first printed reference to a **fizz** (spelled "fiz") is in the 1887 edition of Jerry Thomas ' Bartender's Guide, in which Thomas lists six **fizz** recipes.

Gin Fizz	
IBA Official Cocktail	
Type	Cocktail
Primary alcohol by volume	<a href="#">Gin</a>
Served	<i>On the rocks</i> ; poured over ice
Standard drinkware	<a href="#">Highball glass</a>
<b>IBA specified ingredients</b> <sup>†</sup>	4.5cl (3 parts) <a href="#">Gin</a>
	3cl (2 parts) Fresh <a href="#">lemon</a> juice
	1cl (1 part) <a href="#">Gomme syrup</a>
	8cl (5 parts) <a href="#">Soda Water</a>

A Gin Fizz is the best-known cocktail in the Fizz family. A Gin Fizz contains gin, lemon juice, sugar, and carbonated water, served in a highball glass with two ice cubes. The drink is similar to a [Tom Collins](#), the difference being that a Tom Collins historically used "Old Tom Gin" (a sweetened version of, and precursor to, [London Dry Gin](#)).

Simple variations on the gin fizz are

- **Silver Fizz** — addition of egg white
- **Golden Fizz** — addition of egg yolk
- **Royal Fizz** — addition of whole egg

**Diamond Fizz** — [sparkling wine](#) instead of carbonated water

**Green Fizz** — addition of a dash of green [crème de menthe](#)
